(updated) REGULATIONS PROHIBITING GUAR GUM AS A FOODSTUFF

Published under Government Notice No. R. 2554 of 25 October 1991

The Minister of National Health has, in terms of section 15(1)(e) of the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act No. 54 of 1972), made the regulations contained in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Definition

1. In these regulations "the Act" shall mean the Foodstuffs, Cosmetics and Disinfectants Act, 1972 (Act No. 54 of 1972), and any expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning.

Prohibition of guar gum as a foodstuff

2. For the purposes of section 2(1)(b)(i) of the Act, in so far as it is applied and applicable to foodstuffs, guar gum is hereby deemed to be harmful or injurious to human health unless it is used as an emulsifier, stabilizer or thickener in a foodstuff in accordance with a provision of any regulation made under the Act.
